Knowledge comes from experience, and developing your own projects is a great way to learn. Added benefits: we will be giving out small prizes to the winners of the competition.

## **Prompt:**

Design and develop a fully-functional website about a topic of your choosing. The website can be anything from a personal website, blog, to even your favorite hobby or educational subject. Be creative. Submissions should be submitted by an individual, and only one submission per individual. You may collaborate with others for advice but all code should be written by yourself. The use of outside images or libraries should be documented somewhere on your website.

## **Final Submission Date:**

April 22, 2013. You may submit anytime during and before this date, but not after. Judging will begin shortly after and results will be announced the following week. Submissions should be emailed to [mvwebsitedevelopment@gmail.com](mailto:mvwebsitedevelopment@gmail.com) as a zip file containing all code and media elements for your website.

## **Judging:**

We will be judging based on a super-score of three different categories: design, content, and technical

- Design: Is the website design creative, aesthetically appealing, and consistent across multiple pages?
- Content: Are links and navigation functional, is the topic clearly presented?
- Technical: Is the code valid, readable, and efficient?

Keep these criteria in mind when developing your website.
